Dear CCSC Parents and Guardians,

Enclosed is your child's Quarter 3 Report Card. Please review CCSC's promotion policy, shown in the chart below. I have asked your child's Advisor to call you within the next two weeks if your child is failing or is in danger of failing a core subject. Core subjects are math, science, humanities, English, history, and Spanish. If your child has failed a core subject or is in danger of failing, he or she may be required to attend and pass summer school, or may need to repeat the grade.

If you have any questions about the grading policy, please contact me or another administrator here at CCSC. We want to be very clear about the high expectations we have of our students.

*Many CCSC students choose to attend Summer School for Enrichment

- **No student is allowed to make up more than two courses in summer school.** A failing semester grade in three or more of the above listed courses will result in the student's repeating the school year.
